



WHAT IS COMMUNITY COURT?

A Community Court differs from traditional court in that it seeks to identify and address the underlying challenges of court participants that may contribute to further criminal activity. The team uses a collaborative approach and develops a personalized treatment plan.

It increases collaboration between the criminal justice system and other systems, including mental health, substance use disorder, human services, housing, employment, and education.

Community Court is held in the Redmond Library.

WHAT IS THE RESOURCE CENTER?

The Resource Center is an integral component of Community Court.

It is available to all members of the public in addition to Community Court participants.

The Resource Center is conveniently located in the Redmond Library.

It consists of community partners who provide a wide array of services such as:

- *Healthcare/insurance
- *DSHS access
- *Education
- *Job training
- *Behavioral health
- *Substance use disorder help
- *Housing
- *Food/clothing
- *Library services
- *Transportation
- *Civil legal matters
- *Dispute resolution and mediation
