



Long-term northbound I-5 lane reductions across the Ship Canal Bridge.

Repair and resurfacing of the northbound lanes of the Ship Canal Bridge continues. Revive I-5 construction and other projects throughout the region will have long-term impact on travel. That means the public will need to find long-term solutions to how they travel to and through Seattle.

During each lane closure or reduction, the express lanes will run northbound only, 24 hours a day. Express lanes are open to all. Be sure to observe all height restrictions and HOV-only signed ramps.
